10th December 2024 – The Silicon Eurocluster initiative has concluded its Green Financial Support open call, selecting 25 innovative SMEs from across Europe to receive funding aimed at driving sustainable transformation within the electronics sector. Each SME has been awarded \in 3,600 in financial assistance to engage external consultancy services, helping them transition toward greener and more sustainable business practices.
